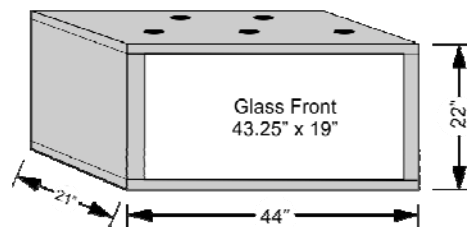


# Albuquerque Gem & Mineral Club Display Case Request

The AGMC has twenty cases available which will be assigned in order of receipt and acceptance of applications. Dimensions of the cases shown on the diagram are inside measurements. All display case requests must accompany a Exhibit entry form. A separate Display Case Request must be completed for each entry.

Since the exact dimensions of individual cases vary, it is best to make your case liners slightly undersized rather than over. Adjust for thicker materials. Cases are lighted and the interior is painted white; cloth covered liners usually improve the appearance of an exhibit, but they are not absolutely necessary. Case bottoms are flat; design your own risers to best show off your material. Every reasonable precaution will be taken for the security of exhibits but we will not accept financial responsibility for losses. You may want to obtain insurance from private sources.
